§101. Rules and Regulations for Use of Parks.

The following rules and regulations are hereby established for the management and protection of the Township of Sewickley parks and facilities, and of the persons using the same;

- A. No person shall be permitted on park ground between the hours of 9:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M., prevailing time, unless on official Township business;
- B. No person shall injure, deface, remove, cut or damage any of the trees, plants, shrubs, buildings, structures, fixtures, benches, or any other property of the Township located within the park;
- C. No person shall willfully make or cause to be made any unreasonable disturbance to the annoyance of other persons peaceably using the park or its facilities;
- D. No person shall set up any booth, table or stand for the sale of any food, drink or other article or articles whatsoever within the park without having first obtained the consent of the Board of Township Supervisors;
- E. No person shall dispose of any waste, litter, garbage or other refuse within the park except in receptacles placed for such purpose;
- F. No person shall carry or otherwise transport any alcoholic beverage into the park nor shall any person imbibe an alcoholic beverage while within the park; and
- G. No person shall operate any motorcycle, motorbike, minibike or similar motorized vehicle in the park except within the areas provided for vehicular parking.
- H. No person shall hunt for, capture or kill or attempt to capture or kill or aid or assist in the capturing or killing of, in any manner, any wild bird or wild animal of any description, either game or otherwise in any park, unless specific permission is granted for a designated area by authority of the Township's Board of Supervisors.

§102. Penalty for Violation.

Any person who shall violate any of the rules and regulations set forth in §101 of this Part 1 shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and costs of prosecution, or, to undergo imprisonment for not more than 30 days.
